You have been accepted to the course HARG21 EU Law, 7.5 ECTS credits. The course runs from 2020-08-31 to 2020-10-30, **beginning with a lecture on Monday August 31, 2020 at 12:15 via Zoom.**

Teaching and examination is to be conducted online and there will be no campus-based teaching for this course. All lectures will be available on the learning platform Canvas, either recorded or streamed through Zoom. Please note however, that the main part of the teaching will not be recorded and you will have to follow the teaching according to schedule. The seminars and group presentations require active participation of all students.

The course's schedule is online-based and changes made to the schedule are immediately visible in the online schedule viewer. It is therefore important that you continually check the schedule and keep yourself informed of any changes.

You have to ensure that you have access to a stable and good computer-based internet connection. An internet connection based on your mobile phone is not sufficient. This is mandatory since teaching will be carried out by streamed videos, online live broadcasting, seminar participation etc. Online teaching also requires access to fully functioning microphones and fully functioning video cameras. Our online teaching model is based on interaction, and students will not be able to receive a passing grade unless they have participated actively – students are to be present to the online teaching platform (Zoom) both with audio and camera on. You have to be able to access Canvas and Zoom.

In order to make you feel well prepared for the upcoming digital elements of the autumn semester a team consisting of various experts at the university will be on stand-by in a virtual zoom room on August 27th between 12-17 to help you with practical and technical questions regarding your upcoming semester. This includes activating your student account, how to use Zoom (often used for lectures online), academic support and academic advisors.
